The above chart represents the term portion of the student's mark which will make up 70% of the final grade. The final summative evaluation makes up 30% of the final grade. **The final exam is composed of an individual oral interview, a listening assessment and written assessment.**

Note that **each CATEGORY is worth either 20% or 30%** of the student's term mark.

All skill categories are not necessarily covered in every assignment. For example, a reading response may only touch on Knowledge and Thinking. Unit oral work will be recorded under Communication. Final summative tests in each unit cover all four skill areas.
